Biography

Dr. Kuang is a professor in hepatopancreatobiliary surgery and interventional ultrasound, majors in minimally invasive treatments for liver cancer, biliary tract cancer and pancreatic cancer, such as laparoscopic surgery, robotic surgery, image-guided tumor ablation etc. Dr. Kuang is interested in the mechanism investigation, precise prevention and treatment of hepatobiliary cancer recurrence and metastasis. He has published more than 100 original articles on Ann Oncol, Hepatology, Nat Commun, Radiology, and Clin Cancer Res in recent years. Besides, he has obtained 10 major grants including National Science Fund for Distinguished Young Scholars of China in 2018, the most important grant for young Chinese physicians. He was awarded “Distinguished Achievement Award” in Asian Conference on Tumor Ablation (ACTA) 2017. Dr. Kuang is nowadays one of the leading experts in the field of liver cancer ablation and research in China. And he was just elected as member of the 10th National Commission of China Association for Science and Technology. He is chairman or vice chairman of many medical associations in China, and also member of many international associations such as IASGO, IHPBA, WCIO and APCIO.
