Biography

Dr. Pua Uei is an Interventional Radiologist in Tan Tock Seng Hospital (TTSH) in Singapore. He received his Basic and Masters degree in Medicine from the National University of Singapore, and board qualification in Diagnostic Radiology from the Royal College of Radiologists in the United Kingdom.

He completed his fellowship in interventional radiology in the University Health Network in Toronto and the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. He is inducted as a fellow in several societies including The Society of Interventional Radiology (SIR), the Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiology Society of Europe (CIRSE), the Royal College of Radiologists (United Kingdom), and the Academy of Medicine, Singapore.

He is a founding and board member of the Society of Interventional Oncology (SIO), the inaugural Chair of the Chapter of Interventional Radiologists in the Academy of Medicine, and a Past President of the Singapore Radiological Society. He has served as an International Visiting Professor of the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA).

He is active in medical education and is an Associate Professor of Radiology at the National University of Singapore. His interest in oncology includes transarterial therapies such as chemo and radioembolization, percutaneous tumor ablation, and spinal augmentation. He has published more than 175 peer-reviewed publications and has been invited to speak at more than 160 regional/international conferences, including leading universities.
