Biography

Professor Jeong Min Lee is currently Professor, in radiology department at Seoul National University Hospital. Professor Lee has published more than 470 scientific articles in international journals and is on the Editorial Board of several journals including *Radiology*, *KJR*, *Cancer Imaging*, and *Liver Cancer*. He also received Honorary fellow of ESGAR, and ISMRM fellow of society 2020, and is a formal member of The Korean Academy of Science and Technology, and National Academy of Medicine of Korea. In addition, Professor Lee is the current president of the Korean Society of Radiology and had served as chair of the educational committee for Korean Society of Magnetic Resonance in Medicine. His main scientific interests include “MR Imaging diagnosis of Hepato-biliary and pancreatic diseases”, “Multiparameteric MRI for oncologic diseases”, “MR Elastography” and “Image guided tumor ablation”. He wrote many influential papers regarding diagnosis of liver cancers and biliary cancers, dual energy CT and functional MR imaging for oncologic diseases, and radiofrequency tumor ablation for liver cancers.
